

YOUTH* INITIATIVE COMMITTEE

PURPOSE: To provide a means for the participation of youth in the activities of WAS and to ensure that WAS considers youth oriented policies and strategies amongst its overall activities.

COMPOSITON:

Co-Chairs: Two people, one of whom must be under the age of 35, appointed by the Executive Officers.

Membership: is at the discretion of the Co-Chairs, in consultation with the Executive Officers and is subject to the following provisions:

- ♣ A minimum of five persons and a maximum of ten, plus the Co-Chairs.
- **↓** There is appropriate representation of each of the Regions.
- ♣ Reasonable gender balance.
- ♣ At least 75% must be under the age of 35.

ROLE OF THE CO-CHAIRS

The Co-Chairs -

- ♣ have the prerogative to invite members to the committee.
- **↓** are responsible for coordinating all activities.
- may appoint sub-committees, with a facilitator who will be responsible for overseeing specific areas and/or activities

Note: should there be disagreement between the Co-Chairs the matter must be referred to the Executive Officers for adjudication.

TERM OF OFFICE

Two years, with an option for a further two. All *ad hoc* committees are subject to review on the appointment of a new WAS Executive Committee.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Committee will:

- ♣ Review WAS policies and proposals to ensure appropriate consideration is given to the sexual health and rights of youth.
- ♣ Develop and implement youth-oriented initiatives (under the approval of the Executive Officers).
- **Lesson** Respond to specific requests from the Executive Committee.
- ♣ Disseminate, monitor and maintain the currency of WAS initiatives in respect to youth sexual health and rights.
- ♣ Assist the promotion and activities of World Sexual Health Day.
- ♣ Make recommendations to the Advisory Committee, as appropriate.
- Provide an annual report on its activities.
